Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date standalone financial results of **SAB INDUSTRIES LIMITED** (the "Company") for the quarter ended **March 31, 2026** and for the year ended **March 31, 2026** ("Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:

- i) is presented in accordance with the requirements of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii) gives a true and fair view in conformity with the applicable Indian accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit and total comprehensive Profit and other financial information of the Company for the quarter ended **March 31, 2026** and of the net Profit and total comprehensive income and other financial information of the Company for the year ended **March 31, 2026**.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143 (10) of the Companies Act, 2013, as amended ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the "Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results" section of our report. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

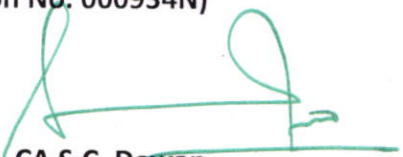

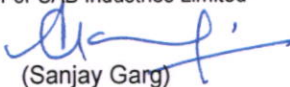

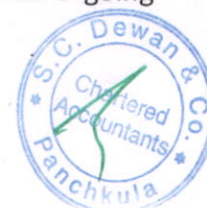


Auditor's Responsibilities
